

CLUB PRESENTATIONS

POINTS TROPHIES

The following trophies are won on points collected at Championship shows where the judge is on the relevant ESSC Judging List and meets the Club's criteria - either having passed the Training of Judges Scheme or having been on the list prior to 1986 - and at the Club Open Shows. They are held for one year, from January to December and must be claimed by 7th January.

The points values are: CC- 6, Res CC - 5, 1st - 4, 2nd - 3, 3rd - 2, Reserve - 1

ANNA GRETA TROPHY (*Mr & Mrs Jones 1962*): For the dog or bitch winning most points at Championship Shows, neither owner nor dog having previously won first, second, third or reserve at Championship shows.

BONHEUR BLUE MERLE PUPPY CUP (*Miss D Currie 1937*): For the blue merle puppy winning most points whilst still in puppyhood.

BONHEUR SABLE & WHITE PUPPY CUP (*Miss D Currie 1934*): For the sable & white puppy winning most points whilst still in puppyhood.

TIBBETS TRICOLOUR PUPPY CUP (*Miss Single 1949*): For the tricolour, black & white or black & tan puppy winning most points whilst still in puppyhood.

SHELERT SUGAR BOWL (*The Misses Herbert 1960*): For the puppy bred by the exhibitor winning most points whilst still in puppyhood..

ISLEEMIST TROPHY (*Mrs G Derbyshire 1992*): For the blue merle dog winning most points during the year.

HILDARKE TROPHY (*Miss D Tate 1993*): For the blue merle bitch winning most points during the year.

MONKSWOOD TROPHY (*Miss M Davis 1992*): For the sable & white dog winning most points during the year.

CH MARRIMEAU LA POUPEE MEMORIAL TROPHY (*Mrs R James 1948*): For the sable & white bitch winning most points during the year.

JONQUIL OF MELVAIG TROPHY (*Mrs J Charlton 1956*): For the sable & white bitch, who must at some time have reared a litter, who wins most points during the year.

SHELERT SALVER (*The Misses Herbert 1957*): For the sable & white winning most points during the year. If a dog, he and his sire must be entire.

CH EBONY PRIDE OF GLENHILL MEMORIAL TROPHY (*Mr & Mrs J McIntosh 1969*): For the tricolour dog winning most points during the year.

BLAISE OF CALLART MEMORIAL TROPHY (*Miss O Gwynne-Jones 1949*): For the home bred sable & white stud dog whose progeny wins most points during the year.

ELLINGTON ENCORE MEMORIAL TROPHY (*Mrs Fishpool 1956*): For the sable & white dog siring most 1st prize winners during the year.

STUD DOG TROPHY (*Mrs F Sangster 1934*): For the dog who has sired most prize winners during the year.

HIGHDALE CUP (*Mr S Meek 1951*): For the stud dog whose progeny win most points during the year his owner need not be the breeder, but both must be Club members.

JOCK OF THE WANSDYKE TROPHY (*Miss Bootle-Wilbraham 1954*): For the tricolour stud dog whose progeny, of any recognised colour, win most points during the year.

FRANCEHILL CUP (*Mrs R Searle 1954*): For the blue merle stud dog whose progeny, of any recognised colour, win most points during the year.

DILHORNE TROPHY (*Mrs C Charlesworth 1956*): For the blue merle bitch whose progeny win most points during the year.

TANGO OF HOUGHTON HILL TROPHY (*Mrs Baker 1959*): For the tricolour, black & white or black & tan bitch whose progeny win most points during the year.

THORNBOROUGH TROPHY (*Major & Mrs J Richardson 1948*): For the bitch whose progeny win most points during the year her owner need not be the breeder but both must be Club members.

CH RIVERHILL RARE GOLD TROPHY (*The Misses Rogers 1963*): For the bitch with the greatest number of children who win 1st, 2nd and 3rd prizes during the year.

HEATHERBELLE OF CALLART MEMORIAL TROPHY (*Miss O Gwynne-Jones*): For the grandmother on the dam's side of the most Ch. Show winners in the year. In the case of a tie CCs take preference. What counts is the number of progeny, not the number of points.

CALLART BREEDERS TROPHY (*Miss O Gwynne-Jones*): For the breeder of the most winners during the year, not necessarily owned by the breeder.

EXFORD TROPHY (*Mrs F Sangster 1932*): For the breeder of the most exhibits winning 1st prizes during the year, not necessarily owned by the breeder. What counts is the number of exhibits, not the number of prizes.

HALLINWOOD VASE (*Mr & Mrs G Bellas-Simpson 1954*): For the member who breeds the exhibits winning most points during the year, not necessarily owned by the breeder, minimum number of exhibits: 2.

CALLART AWARD (*Miss O Gwynne-Jones 1960*): For the kennel winning the most points during the year maximum number of dogs and bitches to be 5, including bitches out on breeding terms. Puppies under 6 months and veterans over 8 years not to be included.

WOOLPITS CHALLENGE CUP (*Miss Scrutton & Miss Vidal*): For the Club member winning most points during the year.

CURRIE CUP (*Miss D Currie 1948*): For the member winning next highest number of points to the winner of the Woolpits Cup.

FRANCEHILL SHELTYE OF THE YEAR TROPHY (*Mrs R Searle 1959*): For the dog or bitch winning the most points during the year.
